



## **E.M. THARP INC. /WORLD AG EXPO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Deadline for Scholarship Application: Friday, January 19, 2018– 5:00 p.m.

The E.M. Tharp Scholarship will be awarded based on eligibility as outlined in the criteria below, as well as the quality of the application. Grades, ACT/SAT scores and financial need will be assessed, but are not the only factors considered when awarding the scholarship. If the applicant is selected for an interview they must bring a professional photo of themselves to the interview. Scholarship winners will be contacted prior to World Ag Expo in February.

The grant will be sent to the university the recipient will be attending in the fall. The recipient of the scholarship must spend the grant within 12 months of award date for tuition, fees, books or other education-related expenses. Failure to use the scholarship within 12 months or use of the scholarship for any purpose other than educational expenses will result in the recipient needing to refund the full amount of the scholarship.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Officially graduate from high school during the 2017-2018 school year
- Acceptance by an accredited 4-year university, if not accepted yet provide which universities you have applied to at this time.
- Future educational and vocational career goals must be related to agriculture
- Applicant must reside in Madera, Fresno, Tulare, Kings or Kern counties
- Completion of scholarship application, including transcripts and letters of recommendation

***Incomplete, hand written, or late applications will not be accepted.***

### **Application Process:**

- Complete application, including letters of recommendation and transcripts, prior to deadline of Friday, January 19, 2018. Must receive application by deadline date, not postmarked.
- Provide a transcript of high school grades and ACT or SAT scores. (Original transcripts in sealed envelope are NOT required.)
- Provide two letters of recommendation
- Do not fold application and place in small envelope.
- Submit **two unstapled copies** of your scholarship application; including transcripts and letters of recommendation to:
