

Exhibitor Appointed Contractor

Deadline: January 15, 2019

This contract must be completed by the World Ag Expo® exhibitor hiring an appointed contractor.

Any contractor or temporary worker not listed in the Exhibitor Resource Directory is an appointed contractor. This includes, but is not limited to: pressure washers, equipment cleaners, landscapers, booth labor, equipment rentals, tent rentals and any other contractor directly hired by an exhibiting company.

Provided by the International Agri-Center® (IAC):

- Allow access to show grounds for appointed contractor to perform contracted duties for World Ag Expo® (WAE) exhibitor, pending receipt of the signed agreement and certificate of insurance from the Exhibitor
- Provide security during specified hours
 - Security outside of set hours is at the sole expense of the contractor and must be arranged with security company

Exhibiting Company agrees to Ensure Appointed Contractor:

- Complies with all applicable laws, regulations, and/or rules promulgated by any government or regulatory agency regarding the services you performed including, but not necessarily limited to, workers' compensation insurance requirements, business licenses, contractor's licenses, etc. IAC takes no responsibility for determining your compliance with any such laws, rules, and regulations.
- Complies with all state and federal work safety laws and regulations and have a written and implemented safety program in place.
- Contracts directly with the exhibitor for their services. International Agri Center® and World Ag Expo® will have no liability or responsibility to the exhibitor or the appointed contractor.
- Complies with all guidelines outlined below:
 - a) Temporary Worker Passes and Badges
 - i. No admittance to the show grounds will be permitted without a temporary worker pass. Passes may be picked up from the IAC main office in advance or at the Exhibitor Registration Center (ERC) at Gate 6 between January 28, 2019 and February 14, 2019.
 - ii. Badges for access during show hours are the sole responsibility of the exhibitor and are provided at their expense.
 - b) Indemnification And Liability Waiver
 - i. Exhibitor and appointed contractor agree to protect, indemnify and hold harmless the International Agri-Center®, and all its officers, directors, employees, staff and agents, from and against any and all liability, loss, expense (including reasonable attorney's fees) or claims for injury or damage, or any liability whatsoever arising out of any appointed contractor actions both related and unrelated to the performance of responsibilities as requested by the exhibitor.
 - ii. IAC does not provide any form of insurance to cover appointed contractor activities at WAE and assumes no liability or responsibility for loss or damage to appointed contractor due to fire, theft, breakage, vandalism or any other reason. IAC recommends that appointed contractor maintain its own insurance to cover any such potential loss or damage.
 - c) Certificate of insurance
 - i. Exhibitor must provide IAC with proof of commercial general liability insurance coverage in the minimum amounts of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate as set forth and agreed to in the Request for Exhibit Space Contract.
 - ii. Exhibitor shall maintain any required workers' compensation insurance for its employees at WAE.
 - d) Water Guidelines
 - i. Water must be obtained from City of Tulare hydrants. Contact (559) 684-4324 regarding obtaining the required city permit. A city permit will be required to obtain water and this requirement will be enforced by the City Water Department.
 - ii. IAC water is NOT available for your services. Anyone using IAC water will be ejected from the grounds.
 - iii. It is your responsibility to keep all water under control so as to avoid spraying neighboring exhibitors' displays, as well as avoiding undue accumulation of water and mud.

e) Grounds Accessibility

- i. Prior to World Ag Expo®, appointed contractor will be allowed access to the grounds to provide your services between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- ii. During World Ag Expo®, appointed contractor will be allowed access to the grounds to provide your services only between the hours of 5:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.
- iii. Be aware of where vehicle/equipment is parked. On the show grounds, park vehicle/equipment close to the subject exhibit space without blocking any roads or other exhibit spaces.

f) Security

Security will be required in order for appointed contractor to perform services on show days between the hours of 7:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m. Security costs will be billed to exhibitor at a rate determined by the security company. Security must be scheduled with the security office (Gate 6) prior to the performance of work or check World Ag Expo® website for current security company.

G) Landscaping

Exhibitor and appointed contractor are fully and financially responsible for placement and removal of any and all materials placed in exhibitor’s space. Sod, bark (if not rented through WAE), plants, rocks and other landscape materials are the sole responsibility of exhibitor and appointed contractor. Items must be placed and removed without use of WAE equipment, labor, water and/or trash receptacles. Exhibitors and appointed contractors must remove all items and return the grounds to their original state by the end of the move-out period (February 22, 2019). Failure to do so will result in possible fines for any cost incurred during placement or clean-up of your materials by WAE staff, removal from the Exhibitor Resource Directory for future shows and possible suspension of privileges as an appointed contractor at future shows.
